Anyone in the Southeastern Iowa Synod who are either passionate about or curious about our companion synod relationships with the Pare Diocese and congregations in the Mwanga Diocese is welcome to attend. Congregations with relationships with congregations in Tanzania or projects underway in partnership with ministries in the dioceses are encouraged to send participants if possible.

August is Back-to-School Scholarships Month for Myamba Lutheran Parish

August—back-to-school month in Iowa—finds St. Peter focusing on our companion congregation in Tanzania, Myamba Lutheran Parish. Our flagship initiative has been the secondary school scholarship program for those Myamba students attending the four years of public secondary school whose families need financial support in order to afford to send their children to school.

A \$100 annual scholarship provides school uniforms, socks and shoes, hot lunch, school fees, testing fees, and school security. Sponsors can also give \$15 to cover the cost of a Swahili Bible for a first-year scholarship student and a notebook and pen given to each scholarship recipient. Scholarship sponsors are partners with students' parents in providing for their education.

95 students are receiving annual scholarships for the 2022 calendar year school year through St. Peter's program. Let's match that number for the 2023 school year beginning January 2023!!

You'll hear more about this program and how you can help during brief Myamba Moments at the beginning of each worship service in August. We're working to obtain spoken word-videos from four of the students who've been receiving scholarships from St. Peter's program to show each Sunday. Pledge cards will be available. Pledge payments can be placed in the offering plates, in the baskets on the information table, received on line or mailed to the office. Please be sure to clearly mark any donations "Myamba Scholarships."

St. Peter's Additional Supports of Myamba Lutheran Parish

While St. Peter's Secondary School Scholarship Program has the most widespread impact on students and families of Myamba Lutheran Parish, St. Peter conducts additional programs to benefit children and families of Myamba. These programs are:

- Scholarships for Myamba students with hearing impairments to attend Mwanga School for the Deaf, a ministry
 of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in Tanzania. Three young children of Myamba Parish are now attending
 Mwanga. Sunday school offerings paid a portion of the costs.
- Medical support for young children of Myamba Parish affected by the excess fluoride in the drinking water that
 causes bowed legs. This condition can be surgically corrected or, in less severe cases, corrected with leg braces.
 Since 2011, two Myamba children have had surgery and one has received braces. A fourth Myamba child has
 recently been identified as having bowed legs in need of correction.
- Contributing St. Peter confirmation offerings toward Myamba confirmation program expenses for curriculum and Bibles. A recent Myamba confirmation class had 104 students.
- Providing education expense support for post-secondary students seeking higher education or vocational training. Requests have been handled on a case by case basis as fund surpluses allow.
- An annual gift of \$2,500 from St. Peter to Myamba, provided by offerings through a General Fund line item. Gifts
 are used for building projects or parish-wide expenses.
- Financial support to nearby Gonja Lutheran Hospital, operated by the Pare Diocese, of which Myamba Parish is a member. Several members contributed to a gift sent to Gonja to purchase pandemic supplies during a time of community spread.

Old Business

- Worship schedule for fall 2022 resumption of 8am/10:30am schedule. Numbers warrant reinstating two services and Sunday School hour would benefit from the later time again at 9:15. Discussion on the need for volunteers to make this successful. Thank you Sunday School for working with last year's one worship schedule.
- Update to 2022 budget— Proposed A/C & furnace increased costs for review and approval by the Congregation. Repair cost \$11845. Possible \$2,000-\$4,000 in additional incidentals if the control board needs replaced. Motion carries to approve \$11,845 bid plus cost of incidentals.
- Ash tree update (costs of Phase I approved by Council in June): 24 Ash trees need to be removed. Removal cost
 could total \$9095 but initially approved up to \$4,500 at Council to remove half of the trees in the parking lot and
 the one close to the church. Will assess how many need to be replaced after removal. Monti offered to treat
 living trees with insecticide in the back of the church to see if we can avoid removal. Thank you Tim Duhn for all
 your work on this.
